TASTING NOTE BY JOSEPH DHAFANA*

An inviting nose of ripe stone fruit and fresh guava leads into a palate defined by balanced, medium acidity. Elegant yet understated, the wine reveals a subtle complexity and refined personality with time in the glass. Its harmonious structure makes it a versatile companion to poultry and a variety of seafood dishes.

VINTAGE NOTES

Harmony Chenin Blanc is old vines – 41-53 years old. 28% Swartland for minerality and 72% Stellenbosch for fruit and complexity. Six months in 250L 2nd and 3rd fill French oak barrels for freshness.
